Divisions:

- Snowboard (Only Snowboarders allowed to enter, no Skiers allowed)
- Powder Puff (Must be a female rider AND female Snowboarder/Skier)
- Young Guns (17 yrs of Age and Younger to Enter)
- Classic (Total Team Age of 80 yrs and Above)
- Open Division 1D, 2D (Must Be 18 yrs or Older to Enter)

Entry Registration:

- Registration will take place at the Railyard in Gillette, WY.
 - Friday February 24th from 5PM to 9PM.
- Registrations will also be accepted the morning of the 25th at the event from 8AM 9AM
- Entries can be taken Friday Night over the phone, but entry fees must be paid at the Crow's Nest by 9AM Saturday morning. Please call 307-689-8426 to enter Friday Night over the phone.

Entry Fees by Division:

- Snowboard (\$50 per person or \$100 per team)
- Powder Puff (\$50 per person or \$100 per team)
- Young Guns (\$25 per person or \$50 per team)
- Classic (\$50 per person or \$100 per team)
- OPEN 1-D, 2-D (\$100 per person or \$200 per team)

General Information:

- Entry fees will be jackpotted with a percentage paid to the average winners of each division.
- Prizes will be awarded to the average winners of each division.
- Each division will consist of a long round and a short round.
- Calcutta for the OPEN 1D & 2D (only) will take place directly after the long round and before the short begins.
- Winners announced and prizes will be awarded after the races are over. Which will take place in front of the crow's nest.

Course Design:

• In designing our course, our main focus is to provide a safe venue for horses, riders, skiers and spectators. We will have a straight track approximately 700' in length. Our track designers work with what mother nature gives us, and will include jumps, rings, and ski gates. Horse track safety is our top priority.

Horse Boarding:

- Stalls are available at the Cam-Plex if needed and reservations are made by calling 307-299-4144.
- Stalls must be cleaned before leaving the event and manure must be placed 6 feet from the stall.
- Stalls are \$20 per night and paid in advance.
- Must provide your own shavings and feed.

Rules:

- One second added for each missed or dropped ring.
- Three seconds added for each missed ski gate or jump, both skis and/or snowboard must be inside the gate
- Skier and/or snowboarder must have a hold of the rope at the start and finish line.
- A dropped rope is a no time.
- Skier and/or snowboarder must start from the Starting Box.
- No contesting any call made by the flagger or judge. All decisions are final. Failure to comply will result in an immediate disqualification and forfeit of your entry fee.
- We suggest no more than 4 runs per horse for their health and safety.
- No times in the long round of any division do not come back to the short round.
- Same rider/skier team can only enter once per division.
